- 2. In what ways is Emerson's advice appropriate to a child's first teacher—his or her own parents?
- 3. Why is the relationship between "Genius and Drill," as Emerson explains it, paradoxical (para. 3)?
- 4. Why does Emerson believe "it is better to teach the child arithmetic and Latin grammar than rhetoric or moral philosophy" (para. 5)?
- 5. In what ways does this essay point out the education system's effect on teachers as well as students?
- 6. What exactly is the "natural method" to which Emerson refers (para. 8)?
- 7. Why does Emerson criticize schools as bureaucratic institutions (para. 10)?
- 8. Describe the adult that Emerson imagines would emerge from an education based on the principles he supports.
- 9. What does Emerson describe as the best way to be educated? Explain. (Para. 13)
- 10. How would you describe Emerson's tone in this essay? Explain.
- 11. Evaluate your own schooling according to the criteria presented in paragraph 10. How is the education that Emerson describes similar to your own? How is it different?
